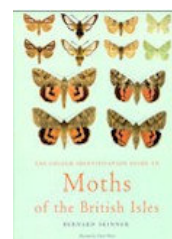

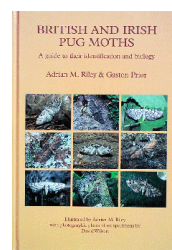
#### British and Irish Pug Moths
